SPECIAL CELEBRATION REMINDER

We welcome you to celebrate your child's birthday or any other special occasion at the center with a nutritious snack. CUBBY BOXES

Children's belongings cannot come into contact with another child's bedding; therefore, each cubby has been supplied with a plastic storage bin. **The cubby container MUST remain on site at all times and cannot be taken home.** We suggest parents bring a pillowcase or reusable bag to transport your child's belonging to and from school. Please refrain from putting any type of lotion, hand sanitizer, sunscreen or diaper ointment in their cubbies. These items cannot be administered without the proper forms and must be stored in the office.
