CURRICULUM

The following areas of focus are common topics that may emerge this month: Community helpers (firefighters, mail carriers, and police officers) Valentine's, and Dental Awareness.

Having this in mind, we invite parents or friends to the school who happen to be a doctor, teacher, nurse, mail carrier, fire fighter, police officer, etc. to share your trade with the children. KINDERGARTEN INFO.

If your child is eligible to enter kindergarten in the fall (they must turn 5 years by September 1st), it's time for you to be visiting the schools in order to register or fill out a transfer request form if you decide not to send your child to your home school. Application submission period begins March 1, 2015.
