The last day to sign up for the trip and submit chaperone immunizations will be March 22^{nd} .

2018-2019 SCHOOL YEAR

If your child will be graduating from Edgewater this summer, be sure to let us know your departure date as soon as possible. We require a minimum of two weeks' notice, but certainly appreciate a longer notice if possible.

If you would like to change your child's schedule (adding or dropping days) we will be sending out a survey for you to fill out and return in April.

If the survey is not returned to us, we will assume that you will be keeping the same schedule for the 2018/2019 school year. Once classes are filled, there may not be a possibility of adding or changing schedules.

Illness Policy Reminder

This has been an exceptionally hard season for illness. Here at Edgewater, we follow all the regulations and requirements to minimize the contagious aspects of the flu; however, we cannot be as effective if we do not have everyone's cooperation. If you notice any signs or symptoms of a contagious illness, please take the proper steps to refrain from spreading communicable diseases. Children must be fever free for 24 hours without medication to attend school. Please remain aware of our illness policy as stated in our Parent Handbook and inform the center of any contagious illnesses. Please make sure to wash your hands and your child's hands upon arrival.
