REMINDER: NEW RATES FOR FALL

In 2016 the State of California enacted legislation known as the Fair Wage Act mandating businesses to increase minimum wages for hourly rate employees. These increases were to be implemented incrementally over time with different municipalities enacting differing amounts and different launch dates. Some increases have occurred, and some are forthcoming. The next mandated increase is to take effect July 1, 2018.

Due to the significant increased expense associated with this law, and to ensure that we maintain our commitment to compensate our employees above minimum wage standards, we will have a 5% cost of quality increase commencing September, 1, 2018. This increase will automatically be reflected on your monthly tuition charge.

We value our relationship with each family and thank you for allowing us to be part of your child's early education journey. We are committed to offering your family a daily exceptional experience. There is no more important component to the delivery of that experience than our valued employees. This cost of quality increase and resulting raise in their compensation continues commitment to that standard. Thank you for your support. We are grateful and will continue to strive to exceed your expectations.

Also due in September is the annual materials fee of \$50 per child.
