The following are acceptable nutritious suggestions: fruit, pudding, yogurt (make fruit sundaes), muffins, 100% fruit popsicles, bagels with flavored cream cheese, frozen yogurt pushups, fruit smoothies, pizza, string cheese, nut free snack bars (fruit or granola. Cupcakes, donuts and cakes are not allowed.

All treats must be commercially prepared, <u>NOT HOME MADE</u>. You are welcome to participate in preparing a treat with the class. No peanut or nut products allowed. Under no circumstances will candy be allowed to be distributed to children at school.

CUBBY BOXES

Children's belongings cannot come into contact with another child's bedding; therefore, each cubby has been supplied with a plastic storage bin. The cubby container MUST remain on site at all times and cannot be taken home. We suggest parents bring a pillowcase or reusable bag to transport your child's belonging to and from school. Please refrain from putting any type of lotion, hand sanitizer, sunscreen or diaper ointment in their cubbies. These items cannot be administered without the proper forms and must be stored in the office.
