CUBBY BOXES

Children's belongings cannot come into contact with another child's belongings; therefore, each cubby has been supplied with a plastic storage bin. **The cubby container MUST remain on site at all times and cannot be taken home.** We suggest parents bring a pillowcase or reusable bag to transport your child's belongings to and from school. *Please refrain from putting any type of lotion, hand sanitizer, sunscreen or diaper ointment in their cubbies.* These items cannot be administered without the proper forms and must be stored in the office.
