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# DATES TO REMEMBER

### **TRANSITIONS**

As you know, it is time for some children to start transitioning into the next classroom. Visiting allows for a slow and easy transition. Visiting and transitions may vary based on the needs of the child. Some of the younger children may remain with their current classroom and some may require longer transition periods. After transitions are complete, the children's cubbies will be moved to their new classroom, and their sign-in sheets will be moved to the appropriate classroom folder. Children who will be transitioning to the next classroom will be in their new classes by September.
