GENERAL REMINDERS

* It is time to take home your child's emergency kit to be restocked for the year. (Please see the attached handout)

*It is also time to review and update your child's Emergency Information Form including contact and authorized pick-up list. Please stop by the office no later than Friday, September 11th to review your current form and make needed changes.

NATIONAL PLAYDOUGH DAY

Wednesday, September 16th is National Play-dough Day. Each classroom will make play dough on that day. Children will get the opportunity to squish, mold, roll, cut, and create figures out of playdough!

CURRICULUM

Common topics that may emerge in September are: "All About Me", "Getting Acquainted", "Feelings", "Birthdays", "My Family", "We Are All the Same/What Makes Us Different", "Friendship", "My 5 Senses", "Human Body", and "How We Grow/Have Different Abilities". The TK classroom may also be exposed to composting and recycling.

HEALTH REMINDERS

It is important that the children in our program stay healthy. We are not licensed to care for ill children, and we depend on you to keep ill children at home. If your child will be out for any health reasons (illnesses, especially communicable diseases), please notify the school as soon as possible.

As a reminder, authorized representatives, must be able to answer "no" to all Health Screening questions for children to be accepted into our care. If any of the answers is a YES, we will not be able to accept your child into our care.

Do any of the below questions apply to your child, you, or anyone in your household within the last 24 hours:

- 1. has had a fever over 100.4?
- 2. has taken any fever reducing medications?
- 3. has a cough, and the individual has not been consulted by a medical provider?
- 4. has difficulty breathing / shortness of breath?
- 5. has any other signs of illness?
- 6. to your knowledge, has had any exposure to another individual with a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case?

If your child shows any of the above symptoms on an off-school day, please keep your child home for observation for 24 hours or a full day, whichever is greater, returning to the center only when symptom free.
