# BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION REMINDER

We allow you to celebrate your child's birthday at the center with a nutritious snack. Here are some nutritious suggestions: pudding, fruit, yogurt, bagels with flavored cream cheese, frozen yogurt, muffins, and 100% fruit popsicles. Cupcakes, cakes and cookies are not allowed for birthday snack and will not be served to the children. treats must be commercially prepared, NOT HOME MADE. In addition, the first ingredient listed for an item **cannot** be corn syrup, sugar, or sweetener. No peanut/nut products allowed, and under no circumstance will candy be allowed to be distributed to children (goodie bags, valentines etc.)

Due to the pandemic, if you would like to bring goodie bags that are not new in the package, we ask that they are provided two days in advance, so they sit in quarantine before being distributed to the children.

#### FRIENDLY REMINDERS

\*Our entry code is for the protection of the children. Please remain conscious of repeating the code outside our front door entry.

\*Please remember, we are always in need of <u>plastic bags</u>. Some examples would be grocery store bags, gently used gallon sized Ziplocs and dog walking bags. Please think of bringing them in for recycling purposes. We utilize them for wet or dirty clothes. (They will be guarantined before use.)
