CLASSROOM TRANSITIONS

Children who are eligible to move to their next classroom will have "visiting days" **as openings occur** in the older classrooms. You will be notified when your child is scheduled to move up, and you will receive a new Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) to complete. *As stated in our Parent Handbook, a new ASQ must be completed when children transition classrooms.*
