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## Week of the Young Child Week of the Young Child is April 17<sup>th</sup> -

21st. Week of the Young Child is an annual celebration sponsored by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC), the world's largest early childhood education association. The purpose of the Week of the Young Child is to focus public attention on the needs of young children, their families, and to recognize the early childhood programs providing services to them. We will have a week full of fun activities and themes for the children (see attached flyer).



#### Tanaka Farms Strawberry Picking Field Trip

The preschool children will be going to Tanaka Farms to go strawberry picking! This field trip is open to Munchkins, Chipmunks, & Muskrats. Each child who attends the trip will ride a wagon, taste different fruits and vegetables, and pick their own strawberries. Children in the Sprites classroom are welcome to attend the field trip but must be accompanied by an adult. All children must have fully mastered the potty learning process, unless accompanied by an adult.

All chaperones must submit proof of their pertussis (Tdap), measles (MMR), 2022 flu vaccine (waiver available), TB test (dated within the last year), and sign a statement of good health (forms available in the office).

The cost is \$40/child and \$30/adult. To sign up: pick up a permission slip

and submit payment (if by cash or check) by Tuesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>. Payment can be made by check, cash (exact change) or by using your Tuition Express account. Tuition Express accounts will be processed on Thursday, April 13<sup>th</sup>. If you would like to purchase an Edgewater t-shirt for your child to wear to the field trip, it may be purchased in the office for \$12 (we accept cash, check, or can be charged to your Tuition Express account).

\*Your child's sheet and blanket must be taken home at the end of each week, laundered, and returned for the following week's use. Borrowed bedding can result in a \$5 laundry fee.
