## NEW SCHOOL YEAR

Our new school year starts **Tuesday, September 2<sup>nd</sup>**. Yearly \$100 material fees will be charged on September 1<sup>st</sup> for all children enrolled before March 1, 2025. This will automatically be added to your tuition. With the new school year and new tuition rates, we will need all families to sign an updated admissions agreement. These agreements will be distributed in your child's sign in/out sheet during the week of **August 4<sup>th</sup>**. Please take the time to review and initial each item and return it to the office by **Friday, August 15<sup>th</sup>**. We also ask that one parent please stop by the office to review your child's Emergency Information form and make any necessary changes/updates by **Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>**.

## MEET & GREET EVENT

As September nears, you will receive your new school year welcome email, including a link to your child's classroom video!

On **Thursday, September 18<sup>th</sup>**, the school will be closing at 4pm for our monthly staff development, and from 5:15 to 5:45pm, there will be a parent/guardian only Meet & Greet.

This is an opportunity for parents/guardians to talk with teachers and with other parents, meet the teaching team, tour your child's classroom, and get information about the classroom. Our Meet & Greet is for adults only.

## CSULB STUDENTS

As some of you already know, Edgewater serves as a lab school for the CSULB Family Consumer Science students. We will be opening our doors for the CSULB fieldwork students again this upcoming fall semester starting the week of September 9<sup>th</sup>!

Some of the benefits of having interns include lower adult to child ratios for daily interactions (children love the extra attention), constant exposure to new and ongoing teaching practices, and new stimulating experiences for children. Edgewater teachers are role models for interns and oversee all guidance and activities involving the children, this sharpens their skills. Interns are never left alone with children, nor do they help in any way with diapering and restroom needs, including changing children's clothes. Interns are required to meet most of the same qualifications as our team members, including background checks and proof of immunizations. They will be wearing vests when performing volunteer hours, so they are easily identified.
