Tanaka Farms

This field trip is open to Munchkins, Chipmunks, & Muskrats. Children must have fully mastered the potty learning process unless accompanied by an adult. **All chaperones must submit proof of their pertussis (Tdap), measles (MMR), 2025 flu vaccine, statement of good health, and TB clearance dated within 1 year.**

Tanaka Farms is in Irvine, California. At Tanaka Farms, the children will go on a tractor ride, taste fresh vegetables, and pick strawberries from the strawberry patch.

The cost is \$40/child and \$36/adult. To sign up: pay and pick up a permission slip from the office by **Tuesday, April 7th**.

2026-2027 SCHOOL YEAR

If your child is graduating from Edgewater this summer, be sure to let us know your departure date as soon as possible. **We require thirty (30) days of advance notice but certainly appreciate longer notice if possible.**

If you would like to change your child's schedule (adding or dropping days), we will be sending out a survey link for you to complete in April.

If the survey is not completed, we will assume that you will be keeping the same schedule for the 2026-2027 school year. Once classes are filled, there may not be a possibility of adding or changing schedules.
